Students Interested in Attending?

Admission is free but space is limited! To register students follow the guidelines below -

- Interested students must be in grades 10-12
- Students must be registered by a teacher to attend, **registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis**
- Each school can register a maximum of 10 students. Additional students will be added to the wait-list
- Students will be encouraged to participate in supervised research activities and should be comfortable around a variety of samples and specimens found in a clinical laboratory
- Teachers are invited but not required to attend
